The Stage operates on a very lean budget with only one employee, our stage manager. To keep tickets affordable, \$25 for seniors/students and \$28 for general admission, The Stage relies on contributions and sponsorships. For the nine months ending 9/30/24, donations/grants/sponsorships accounting for 43% of our \$84,238 gross revenue. Only with ongoing support from our community can The Stage continue to offer top-quality live theater in Cameron Park.
